Chapter 6 In the Event of a Fall

Step 1

In the event of a fall, the company's established rescue plan should be implemented. (If possible, rescue to be performed from the ground).



In the Event of a Fall - Step 2

Report the incident to a supervisor and ensure complete documentation. The exact sequence of events that led to the fall must be narrated and documented in detail.

Ensure all the soft goods and system components are either serviced/ recertified or completely replaced, in accordance with the legislative requirements and manufacturer's recommendations.



In the Event of a Fall - Step 3

Full-body harness (as per CSA and ANSI Standard) should be removed from service, destroyed and replaced.



In the Event of a Fall - Step 4

Self Retracting Lanyard (as per CSA and ANSI Standard) should be serviced and re-certified. Return to Trittech for service and recertification.



In the Event of a Fall - Step 5

Shock Absorbing Lanyard (as per CSA and ANSI Standard) should be removed from service, destroyed and replaced.



In the Event of a Fall - Step 6

Carabiner (as per CSA and ANSI Standard) should be removed from service, destroyed and replaced.



In the Event of a Fall - Step 7

Link (as per manufacturer recommendations) should be removed from service, destroyed and replaced.



In the Event of a Fall - Step 8

Transfastener (as per manufacturer recommendations) should be removed from service and returned to Trittech for service. Trolley, should be removed from service, destroyed and replaced.



In the Event of a Fall - Step 9

The Fall Protection System should be taken out of service immediately. Contact Trittech for system inspection, service and re-certification. The system must not be used until serviced.
